## Missouri Wing Civil Air Patrol

### Fort Leonard Wood, June 18-25 2022

If you are interested in a great education in Civil Air Patrol emergency services, Missouri Wing is as far as you need to look. The Pathfinder Technical School has deep roots in providing search and rescue training for Civil Air Patrol members back to the 1980's. Today we are still proud to teach the realities of search and rescue in Missouri.



**Basic Pathfinder Course** This course is open to any CAP member that has completed either the Curry Achievement and is at least 14 years of age or seniors who have completed Level 1 training. The physically and mentally demanding course teaches both search and rescue & disaster response skills. Students will be exposed to the wild terrain of the Mark Twain National Forest to practice SAR skills, land navigation and basic survival. Not only do students depart with ground team member qualifications and a sense of accomplishment, they are given the coveted title of PATHFINDER. Course fees include all training materials, food and lodging. **\$175**



**Field Medical Course** This course is open to any cadet who has completed the Curry Achievement and is at least 15 years old and all senior members that have completed Level 1 training. Students will complete both classroom and hands on training evolutions to complete the American Health & Safety Emergency Medical Responder course. The course includes 40 + hours of instruction on patient assessment and treatment. Students will have practical evolutions in the field during the basic course deployment where they will be able to practice the skills learned earlier in the week. Course fees include all training materials, food and lodging. **\$250**



**Ground Team Leader Course** This course is open to any CAP member that is at least 16 years old that is pursuing the Ground Team Leader qualification. In addition to the basic Pathfinder instruction, students will participate in break out courses that will help develop them into competent Ground Team Leaders. By the end of the course the student will have completed both Ground Team Leader and PATHFINDER qualifications. In order to apply the member must be at least 50% done with the GTM3 SQTR. Members should be able to complete a 10 mile cross country exercise in the Mark Twain National Forest. Course fees include all training materials, food and lodging. **\$175**



**Communications Course** This course is perfect for any member with a deep interest in communications. A in depth study of Civil Air Patrols communications, systems and equipment will be presented with hands on practice in a variety of applications. Basic electronics, technical skills and CAP communications qualifications will be included. In addition students will have the opportunity to complete the study and testing for for the FCC amateur radio technician exam. Students must have Curry or Level 1 training completed. In addition cadets must be at least 15 yrs old. Course fees include all training materials, food and lodging. **\$200**

All courses will complete the week with two large hands on training incidents. These incidents will test the skills learned during the course in high stress and realistic environment.

All applicants must have completed GES (CAPT 116) and ICUT (at least online training)
